<u>January – April</u>

• **Determine if you are eligible** under the Massachusetts free community college tuition program. https://www.mass.gov/info-details/free-community-college

• Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is not required by Cape Cod Community College (4Cs) or by ACCE but could save you thousands of dollars and provide access to various student services. If you are interested, it can be completed online at FAFSA.gov or FinAid@capecod.edu. • Submit your official High School transcript to 4Cs

• Take your English and Math Placement Tests
